The Pub and its Facilities

This highly traditional village pub is divided into 3 trading areas. There is a split-level lounge with 32 covers, a working open fire and retractable big screen with HD projector. The public bar has a feature open fireplace, exposed stone walls and oak beam ceilings, with 12 more covers. Just off the public bar is a refurbished, comfortable snug with a chesterfield sofa, large armchairs and interesting bric-a-brac. There is a central bar servery with 3 handpumps and a range of lagers, ciders, wines and spirits. The good-sized catering kitchen has a full range of appliances and preparation facilities. Externally there is a small car park for 5 vehicles, with the bulk of the outside space utilised as an external drinking and dining area with 26 covers, where a marquee can be used in cooler weather.

Corby Glen is an affluent Lincolnshire village of 1,500 people, 3 miles from the busy town of Bourne and 5 miles from the Al and the Intercity Trainline which runs from Grantham only 9 miles away.
